About this qualification

The Level 3 Award in ICT in Early Years provides learners with the knowledge and skills to be able to integrate the use of ICT in Early Years learning.

Entry requirements

Learners must be at least 16 years of age. We do not set any other entry requirements, but colleges or training providers may have their own guidelines.

Experience in a real work environment

During the delivery of this qualification, learners will need to be working or volunteering in early year's settings in order to meet the requirements for assessment. No simulation will be permitted.

Qualification structure

In order to achieve the NCFE CACHE Level 3 Award in ICT in Early Years (QRN: 603/0994/5), learners must achieve 2 mandatory units.

Assessment

To gain this qualification the learner will need to achieve the following:

Pass in all units

All units will be internally assessed using a range of methods, including direct observation within the workplace, a portfolio of evidence, written assignments or a task which we have set.

Competence in a real work environment

Full achievement of the qualification will not be possible until all components are completed. Unit certification will be available.

Progression

This qualification would contribute and support progression to the workplace in job roles such as nursery nurse. The learner can undertake a higher level qualification or they can apply to join a degree programme in a relevant study area.

This qualification will provide career opportunities for the learner as a:

- practitioner in nursery schools

- pre-school worker.
