



NCFE CACHE Level 3 Award in Preparing to Work in Home Based Childcare (England)

Qualification facts

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About this qualification

The NCFE CACHE Level 3 Award in Preparing to Work in Home Based Childcare has been developed in collaboration with the Professional Association for Childcare and Early Years (PACEY).

This qualification prepares learners to set up a home based childcare setting. It is also suitable for learners who wish to be employed in home based childcare settings as childminding assistants or other home childcarers (e.g. nannies, au pairs).

Entry requirements

Learners should be at least 16 years old. We do not set any other entry requirements but colleges or training providers may have their own guidelines.

Experience in the workplace

This is a knowledge-only qualification; therefore, no placement in a real work environment is required.

Qualification structure

In order to achieve this qualification learners must achieve 6 credits from the 2 mandatory units. Guided Learning Hours: 50

Assessment

The qualification will be internally assessed using a range of assessment methods. This could include a portfolio of evidence, written assignments or a task set by us.

Progression

This qualification prepares learners to set up a home based childcare setting. It is also suitable for learners who wish to be employed in home based childcare settings as childminding assistants or other home childcarers (e.g. nannies, au pairs).

Although it does not provide direct progression, the subjects covered in this Award make a useful introduction to our Early Years Educator qualifications.
